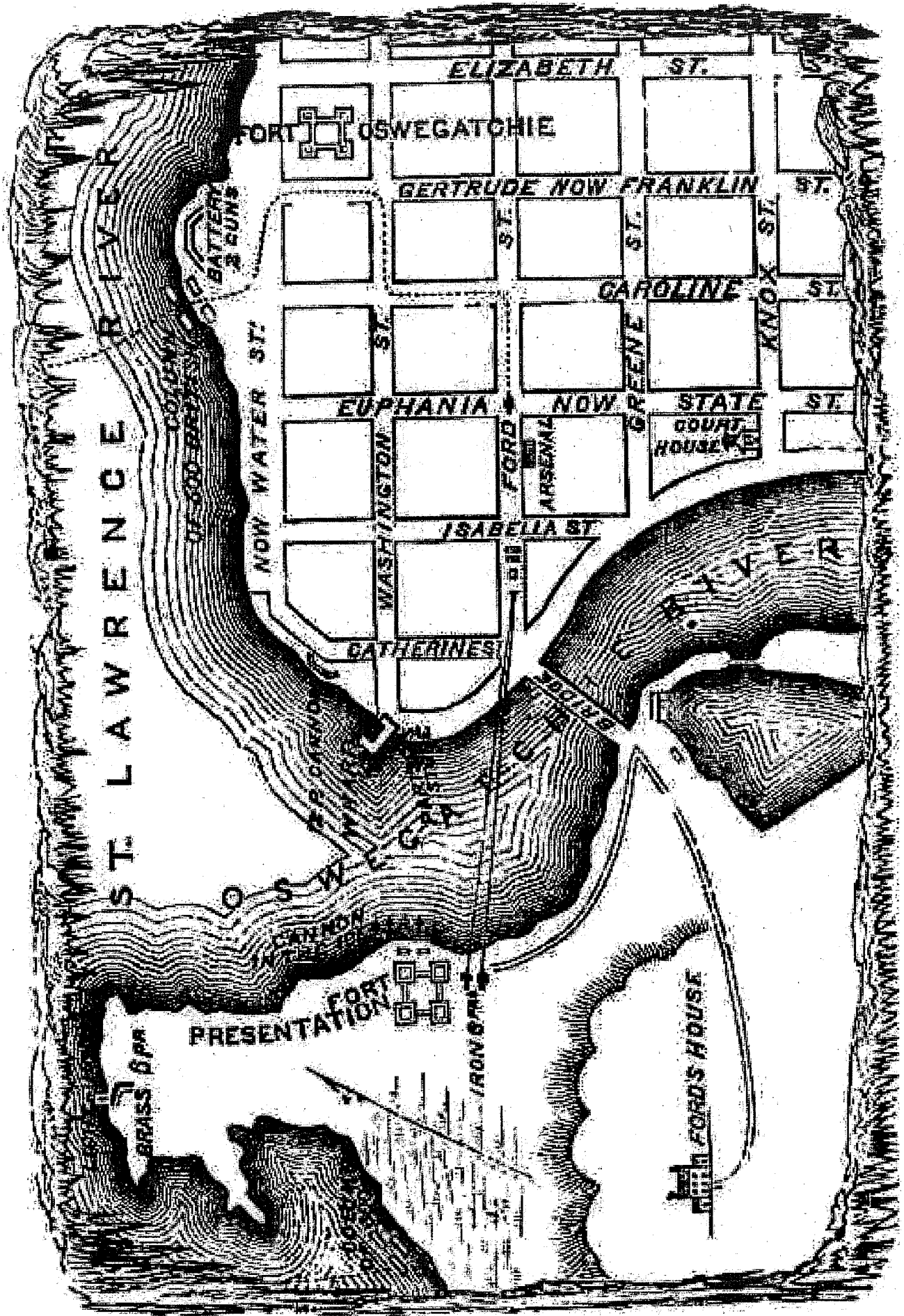
**RESOLUTION OF THE OGDENSBURG CITY COUNCIL
