



The Oswegatchie River Blueway Trail connects and supports recreation along the River. The trail follows the River as it flows quietly through flatwater, trips through rapids and cascades over dams and falls. Experience the Oswegatchie from the water and be rewarded with views you won't see from a car. Leave behind the busy streets for a voyage into the true North Country.


The Oswegatchie River

Winding through pristine wilderness areas, farmers' fields and historic communities, the Oswegatchie River provides a glimpse into life in the North Country. Here you can reconnect with the raw beauty of nature. A place where your compass is your guide and you can see the stars at night.

About the River

The Oswegatchie River covers approximately 450 miles and flows north from its headwaters in the Adirondacks to the City of Ogdensburg where it empties into the St. Lawrence River. The elevation of the River and its watershed ranges from 2,503 to 239 feet above sea level. With areas of flatwater and whitewater, the Oswegatchie River has an array of water-based recreation opportunities.

Outdoor Recreation

Capturing your sense of adventure, the Oswegatchie River Blueway Trail offers abundant opportunities for outdoor recreation. The Trail is a destination for nature lovers and outdoor enthusiasts to enjoy a variety of activities including...

Paddling

With flatwater and whitewater areas, the River offers a wide range of canoeing and kayaking trips for experienced and novice paddlers. Access to the River can be found on New York State Department of Environmental Conservation (DEC) Land and at specific boat launch locations.

Fishing

A variety of warmwater fish can be found in the Oswegatchie River including large and small mouth bass, northern pike, pan fish, brook trout and splake. Check with the New York State DEC for fishing license information (www.dec.ny.gov)

Boating

In the flatwater areas of the Oswegatchie River, visitors can enjoy motorized and non-motorized boating excursions.

Camping

No outdoor retreat is complete without a chance to sleep under the stars. Throughout the Blueway Trail there are several types of camping facilities available including campgrounds, lean-tos and primitive campsites.

Exploring

The River connects to hiking, biking, cross-country skiing, snowshoeing and snowmobiling trails for a complete water and land expedition into the North Country.





Stops Along the River

As you meander through the North Country along the Oswegatchie River Blueway Trail you'll find unique attractions off the beaten path. The Blueway Trail reveals a variety of places to stop for a picnic, to see and experience authentic local heritage and culture or pick up some local goods in the area's small community hubs – all while enjoying the River's rustic charm.

North Country Communities

Located at the northern reaches of New York State, the Blueway Trail is characterized by its scenic qualities and isolated countryside. This area is also rich in cultural and industrial heritage reflecting its wealth of natural resources and position at the State's northern frontier. Today the Oswegatchie River is dotted with quaint North Country community hubs, the largest being the City of Ogdensburg and Village of Gouverneur.

The following section highlights primary stops along the Blueway Trail from the north at the City of Ogdensburg and traveling south to the River's headwaters in the Adirondacks.



At the mouth of the Oswegatchie River where it meets the St. Lawrence River, the City of Ogdensburg is the largest urban area along the Blueway Trail. Here you can gear up for your trip into the wilderness of the North Country, but first be sure to visit these key attractions...



Maple City Trail

A walk along the Maple City Trail takes you on a 2.2-mile paved pathway that follows the banks of the Oswegatchie River. From here you can see different types of trees, aquatic plants and flowers. Many different creatures have been spotted here, including fox, beaver, mink and deer.

Heuvelton & Rensselaer Falls

The villages of Heuvelton and Rensselaer Falls feature rural community life. Surrounded by farmland, the villages are quaint community centers with authentically local attractions like general stores, public libraries and post offices.

Indian Creek Nature Center

Within the Upper and Lower Lakes WMA is the Indian Creek Nature Center, an approximately 320-acre area with 7.9 miles of trails, including a boardwalk trail and overlook. During the spring and fall the Center offers guided nature programs.

Upper and Lower Lakes Wildlife Management Area (WMA)

Bordering the Village of Rensselaer Falls and east of the Oswegatchie River is an 8,757-acre developed wetland complex called the Upper and Lower Lakes Wildlife Management Area (WMA). With its shallow and deep water emergent marsh, forested upland, brush land and open meadow, the WMA serves to maintain wildlife habitats. It is divided into three zones (refuge, restricted use and public hunting areas). For handicapped visitors, the WMA provides accessible parking and a 600-foot-long trail. Gouverneur

East Main Street in Gouverneur

Gouverneur has been termed “Marble Village” for its concentration of marble structures and historic connection to the mining industry. With a traditional commercial main street that faces the Village Green, Gouverneur is a walkable community hub along the Oswegatchie River.



Village Green

A great place to stop in the Village of Gouverneur is the Village Green. Here you can view the Main Street establishments from a picturesque park setting. The park is the site of a monument to Edward John Noble who founded the Life Savers Candy Company in 1913. In honor of Noble, a giant package of Pep-O-Mint Life Savers adorns the Village Green. In the summer time the Green hosts a local Farmers’ Market where you can pick up local seasonal produce.

| Beaver Creek State Forest | 3,694 acres in the towns of Gouverneur, Depeyster and Macomb that provide access to camping, hiking, paddling, hunting and trapping, and cross-country skiing and snowshoeing. |
| Pulpit Rock State Forest | 1,603 acres in the Town of Theresa that feature Payne Lake Public Fishing Access Site, a unique rock formation and two hiking trails (Root Trail and Watson Trail). |
| Yellow Lake State Forest | 751 acres in the Town of Rossie that feature the Yellow Lake Overlook Trail, scenic overlooks bordering Yellow Lake, hunting, hiking and nature viewing. |

Edwards & Harrisville

Bridge to Grand View Island Park in Harrisville

Edwards and Harrisville are small communities along the Oswegatchie River as it enters into more rugged terrain of the Blueway Trail. The former mining town of Edwards and the historic railway town of Harrisville are picturesque North Country stops as you journey into the wilderness.

Grand View Island Park

This extraordinary park is located on an island in the Oswegatchie River just outside the business area of Harrisville. The park offers picnic facilities and scenic overlooks.

The former Harrisville Train Depot is home to the Town of Diana Historical Museum, which provides historical information about Harrisville and the local small villages and towns.







| Bonaparte's Cave State Forest | 1,435 acre site between Lake Bonaparte and the Village of Harrisville that features Green Pond Accessible Fishing Pier. |
| Bonner Lake State Forest | 98 acres of undeveloped areas in the Town of Edwards for hunting, hiking and nature viewing. |
| California Road State Forest | 1,410 acres in the Towns of Pitcairn and Fowler. Offers camping; hiking, biking, hunting and trapping, fishing, and cross-country skiing and snowshoeing. |
| Cold Spring Brook State Forest | Located south of Bonner Lake State Forest. |
| Frank E. Jadwin Memorial State Forest | 20,412 acres in the towns of Croghan and Diana. It is a large and diverse state forest. |
| Greenwood Creek State Forest | 1,009 acres in the Town of Pitcairn with a picnic area and nature trail. |
| Stammer Creek State Forest | 460 acres in the Town of Edwards that feature Sugar Bush Haul Road, which is maintained as a snowmobile trail. |
| Toothaker Creek State Forest | Located east of California Road State Forest. |
| Wolf Lake State Forest | 4,316 acres that feature several trails and lean-to's. |



State Forests

A key characteristic of this region is its concentration of state forests. With a variety of facilities spread across 9 different areas, the region is a hub for outdoor recreation enthusiasts.

The most wild and remote areas of the Adirondacks can be found around Cranberry Lake. Here you can disconnect from it all and enjoy the peacefulness of the North Country's wildlife and rugged terrain.



Wilderness Areas

A primary characteristic of this area is its secluded Adirondack wilderness areas including the 107,230-acre Five Ponds Wilderness Area and the 23,816-acre Pepperbox Wilderness Area. Both support hiking, camping, canoeing and kayaking, fishing, hunting and trapping, cross-country skiing and snowshoeing and wildlife viewing. The Pepperbox Wilderness Area also features the 800-foot-long Sand Pond Accessible Trail.

Cranberry Lake State Campground

A stunning location for outdoor enthusiasts, Cranberry Lake State Campground offers access to one of the largest lakes in the Adirondacks and provides a variety of modern amenities. The campground has 173 campsites and hot showers, flush toilets, trailer dump station and

recycling center as well as a boat launch near the hamlet of Cranberry Lake, sand beach with bathhouse, amphitheater, fishing pier and a picnic area featuring tables, fireplaces and grills.



| Cranberry Lake Wild Forest | 24,111 acre forest with 15 miles of foot trails, 9.4 miles of snowmobile trails, 8.5 miles of ski trails, and two Adirondack lean-tos. |
| Grasse River Wild Forest | Waterfall views at Lampson Falls Trail and the Tooley Pond Campsite and Waterway Access in the Town of Clare. |
| Watson's East Triangle Wild Forest | 13,417 acres in the Town of Webb and the Town of Croghan with camping, hunting, fishing, mountain biking, snowmobile trails, canoeing and kayaking. |
