Subject: Recreational Vehicles & Trailers Parked on City Streets Overnight

Over the past few weeks, the Ogdensburg Police Department & Ogdensburg Code Enforcement Office has received numerous complaints regarding recreational vehicles and trailers parked on city streets overnight. Rather than immediately ticket and/or tow these vehicles we are releasing the following information in hopes to educate the public on the City of Ogdensburg Municipal Code.

Section 209.59-A - Prohibits Parking a recreational vehicle on a public street, or public property, between the hours of 10:00 PM and 6:00 AM without a permit.

- A recreational vehicle is defined as any trailer, camper trailer, boat and trailer, camper, mobile home, motor home, bus or similar vehicle.
- A maximum of (4) permits per year, each not to exceed 72 hours, may be obtained by a person to allow for overnight parking of recreational vehicles.
- Permits may be obtained at the Ogdensburg Police Department, located at 800 Park Street, Ogdensburg New York.
- No Permit Fee is required.
